 - Provide information & help you navigate internal (NSCS) mechanisms • Requests, Complaints, Disciplinary sanction, Adjudication, etc.
- Provide information and help you address concerns regarding healthcare
- Help you navigate external complaint mechanisms
 - NS Human Rights Commission, Ombudsman, Etc.
- Gather information for systemic advocacy (to inform institutional rules and practices)
- Provide individual non-legal advocacy when needed
- Have conversations about the conditions of your incarceration
